The farm aims to supply the freshest, hand-grown veg to members on a subscription basis. It's the next best thing to growing your own.



Community

We provide opportunities for members to connect more personally with food, how it is grown, the countryside and with others. We have weekly volunteer days and host farm events throughout the seasons.

Support

Our members help us to grow. Plotgate Community Farm is a co-operative, in the hands of its members. CSAs sell direct to consumers and ask their members to share in the seasonality of the produce; through the hungry gap and the summer abundance, members pay a regular amount for a share of the harvest.

Agriculture

We are committed to truly sustainable food, produced with a spirit of low-carbon innovative. We use certified organic, home grown or locally supplied inputs. All our food is naturally grown. We grow all the fresh produce on the field at Plotgate and buy in only a few stored roots in the winter months- these are sourced from local, Organic certified producers.

How to Get Your Vegetables...

We distribute veg through pop-up food hubs where members collect their harvest shares (veg boxes) and by delivery straight to your doorstep.

We aim to provide something for everyone! Veg members subscribe to a weekly or a fortnightly share of our harvest. Standard sized boxes (8 items +) or small boxes (6 items +) are available, and we ask small box customers to choose "more roots" or "more leaves" as a preference.

At the collection hubs, we always have a swaps box for people to change unwanted items.

Mondays: Glastonbury Collection Point from 4.30pm, Street Collection Point from 5pm.

Local delivery covering Butleigh, Baltonsborough, West Pennard, Glastonbury, Street, and the surrounding area 4-6.30pm.

Fridays: Collection from The Barton Inn, Barton St David 4 – 6.30pm.

Saturdays: Collection from the Bridge Cafe, Langport 10am-2pm. Local delivery to Keinton Mandeville, Kingweston, The Charltons, Somerton, Langport, and Compton Dundon 9am-11.30am.

We run annual basketry, holly wreath making and wool workshops, and are always expanding what is on offer including courses for growers and gardeners.
